# VI. Practical Ways to \_\_\_\_\_\_ your life in the church A. Meet Pressing \_\_\_\_\_

**Tit 3:14 NASB95 -** 14 Our people must also learn to engage in good deeds to meet pressing needs, so that they will not be unfruitful.

#### B. Practice the \_\_\_\_\_

**Rom 12:10-13 NASB95 -** 10 [Be] devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; 11 not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; 12 rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, 13 contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality.

Gal 6:1 NASB95 - 1 Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; [each one] looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted.
