I. What is Arianism? –

Principle Error: The erroneous doctrine that denies the full deity of the Jesus Christ and of the Holy Spirit. "Arius taught that God the Son was at one point created by God the Father, and that before that time the Son did not exist, nor did the Holy Spirit, but the Father only. Thus though the heavenly Son is a heavenly being who existed before the rest of creation and who is far greater than all the rest of creation, he is still not equal to the Father in all his attributes – he may even be said to be 'like the Father' or 'similar to the Father' in his nature, but he cannot be said to be 'of the same nature' as the Father.

Who was Arius? A presbyter (pastor) of Alexandria in northern Africa (Egypt) after 313, - - - a proud, artful, restless and disputatious, pressed and overstated the Origenistic view of the subordination, accused Alexander, the Bishop of Alexandria, of Sabellianism, and taught that Christ, while he was indeed the creator of the world, was himself a creature of God, therefore not truly divine.

Why Do We Say that These Two Doctrinal Areas are Essentials of the Faith? Thus when denied, they are classified as "heresy" in the Church! Consider:

Ps 2:10-12 Now therefore, O kings, show discernment; take warning, O judges of the earth. ¹¹Worship the Lord with reverence and rejoice with trembling. ¹²Do homage to the Son, that He not become angry, and you perish in the way, For His wrath may soon be kindled. When commissioning Moses to bring His people out of Egypt and into the land of Canaan, Moses, when confronted by God at the burning bush asked God His name! God replied:

"Tetragrammaton, is the four-letter <u>Hebrew theonym</u> ההה (transliterated as YHWH), the name of the <u>national god</u> of Israel. The four letters, written and read from right to left, are <u>yodh</u>, <u>he</u>, <u>waw</u>, and <u>he</u>.[1] The name may be derived from a verb that means "to be", "to exist", "to cause to become", or "to come to pass".[2][3] While there is no consensus about the structure and etymology of the name, the form <u>Yahweh</u> is now accepted almost universally." The "I am" Series of the Gospel of John; Jesus demonstrates repeated claim to be God, very God!

John Chrysostom (ca. 349-407) attached more theological significance to <u>ego eimi</u>, in his 55th Homily
on John: "But wherefore said He not, Before Abraham was, "I was" (εγω ην), instead of "I Am" (εγω
ειμι)? As the Father uses this expression, I Am (εγω ειμι), so also does Christ; for it signifies
continuous Being, irrespective of all time. On which account the expression seemed to them to be
blasphemous." [6]

- **Jn 6:35** *Jesus said to them,* "<u>I am</u> *the bread of life, he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in me will never thirst.*"
- **Jn 8:12** Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "<u>I am</u> the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the Light of life."
- Jn 8:18 "I am He who testifies about Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies about Me."
- Jn 8:23 And He was saying to them, "You are from below, <u>I am</u> from above; you are of this world, <u>I am</u> not of this world."
- **Jn 8:24** "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for **unless you believe that** <u>I am</u> **He**, you will die in your sins.
- **Jn 8:28** So Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that <u>I am</u> He, and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father taught Me."
- **Jn 8:58-59** Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **before Abraham was born**, <u>I am</u>."

 Therefore **they picked up stones to throw at Him**, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

They knew and understood what Jesus was saying to them. He is the Son of God! They supposed correctly that for a mere man to say such a thing was deserving of the death penalty.

Original text of the Nicene Creed: "We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, begotten of the Father, the only-begotten; that is, of the essence of the Father, God of God, Light of light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance (homoousion) with the Father "

Heb 1:1-4 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ²in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. ³And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴having become as much better than the angels, as He has inherited a more excellent name than they.

Continue reading through v. 14!!

John 1:1-5 <u>In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.</u> ²<u>He was in the beginning with God.</u> ³<u>All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.</u> ⁴In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. ⁵The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

Men, even many professing Christians (then and now) did not and still do not comprehend this truth of who Jesus the Christ is. Men seek to reject who He really is because it is an offense to their very nature of being in darkness without the regeneration of the heart into a new creation in Christ and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. !!!

Eph 2:13-22 But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. ¹⁴For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, ¹⁵by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace, ¹⁶and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity. ¹⁷AND HE CAME AND PREACHED PEACE TO YOU WHO WERE FAR AWAY, AND PEACE TO THOSE WHO WERE NEAR; ¹⁸for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, ²⁰having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, ²¹in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, ²²in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

Everyone holds to some sort of doctrine; the question is whether or not our doctrine is biblical. Consequently, we dare not be indifferent about doctrine. Indeed, there is a reason we've never heard of a Christian martyr who was indifferent about doctrine. Indifference about doctrine is the mother of every heresy in all of history, and in our day indifference about doctrine is spreading like wildfire in the pulpits and pews of our churches. Ironically, the assertion that doctrine doesn't matter is in fact a doctrine in itself.

And twenty years from now, men will point their finger back at us and say of us, this is the result of the flow of history . . .
