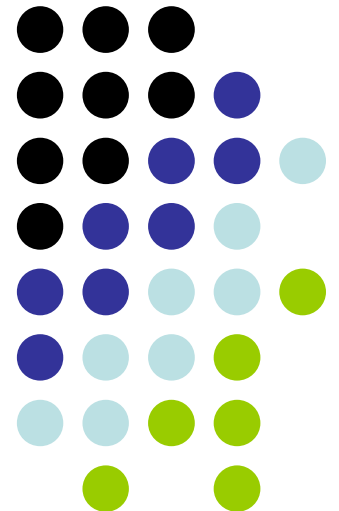

# John 14:26



**“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.**

# John 14:16



- “I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever

# I. The Holy Spirit is a Person (1/2)



## A. Attributes of Personality

1. Intellect- He possesses the ability to know and understand reality.

a. Romans 8:27:

*The Holy Spirit has a mind.*

b. 1 Corinthians 2:10:

*The Holy Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God.*

c. 1 Corinthians 2:11:

*The Holy Spirit knows the things of God.*

# I. The Holy Spirit is a Person (2/2)



**2. Emotion- He possesses the ability to experience emotion.**

**What emotion is attributed to the Holy Spirit in Ephesians 4:30.**

***The ability to be “grieved.”***



# I. The Holy Spirit is a Person (2/2)

## 3. Volition- He possesses the ability act decisively.

How do you see the Spirit work in the following verses:

a. 1 Corinthians 12:7 & 11:

*To be made manifest (known) to individuals as He chooses.*

b. Acts 13:2:

*He appoints people to specific ministries.*

## II. The Holy Spirit is God

### A. Attributes

Holy Spirit: Attributes of Deity		
Omniscient	All-knowing	<a href="#">Isaiah 40:13-14</a>
Omnipresent	Present everywhere	<a href="#">Psalm 139:7</a>
Eternal	Without beginning or end	<a href="#">Hebrews 9:14</a>
Truth	Veracity; Integrity	<a href="#">1 John 5:7</a> <a href="#">John 16:13</a>

### B. Statements of Deity

1. Key statement that shows that the Holy Spirit is God.  
([2 Corinthians 3:17](#))

*They are one. The Lord is the Holy Spirit.*

2. According to [Acts 5:3-4](#), lying to the Holy Spirit is the same thing as lying to  
*God.*

# The Holy Spirit is God



- The Spirit of Truth – I John 5:6
- The Spirit of Life – Romans 8:2
  - Jesus is called the truth and the life- John 14:6
- The Living Water – John 7:38-39
  - Jesus is called the living bread- John 6:51
  - The Father is called living Father- John 6:57
- Spirit of Glory – 1 Peter 4:14
  - Jesus is called the Lord of glory – I Cor 2:8
  - The Father is called the Father of glory Eph 1:17

# The Trinity



- There is only one God. ISA 43:10, ISA 45:22
- God refers to Himself in the plural.  
Gen 1:26a, 3:22
- The Father is God. John 6:27
- Christ is God. Titus 2:13, John 1:1, 8:58
- The Holy Spirit is God. Acts 5:3-4

# The Trinity



- The Three Are Distinct From Each Other
- At the Baptism of Christ. Mark 1:10-11
- Trinitarian Statements. 1 Pet 1:2;  
1Cor 12:4-6; Matt 28:19

# The Trinity



- There is **ONE** living God, eternally existing in three Persons: the Father; the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- They are co-equal, co-eternal, and co-substantial (of the same essence)
- All three therefore deserve equal worship and obedience



# The Trinity



- **The Father**

- From whom all revelation proceeds;
- Who foreknew our salvation
- Demonstrated His love for us by giving His only Son

## **The Son**

- The incarnate God who gave Himself as a sacrifice for sin
- He now intercedes and mediates between the Father and man

## **The Holy Spirit**

- Indwells the believer and seals as God's possession
- Sanctifies the believer through the Word
