God's Sovereign Will

<u>Isaiah 14:24</u> <u>Isaiah 46:9-10</u>

- Everything will happen exactly as God planned according to His foreknowledge
- Salvation predestination Romans 8:29-30
- Predetermined plan of salvation Acts 2:22-23
- Governments set up by God Romans 13:1
- Do we live our lives with the view that all that happens in history has already been written by God?

- Be self sacrificing Rom 12:1-2 (lesson 9)
